

ABOUT BUCHAREST

Bucharest, city and municipality, is the economic, administrative, and cultural centre of Romania. The first written appearance of the name "București" dates from 1459, when it was recorded in a signed document of Vlad III (the Impaler), the ruler of Walachia. Vlad III built the fortress of Bucharest—the first of many fortifications—with the aim of holding back the Turks who were threatening the existence of the Walachian state.



The modern city is characterized by a number of museums, art galleries, squares, old and new streets and boulevards. The two major streets, running roughly parallel through the centre of the city, are Calea Victoriei and Bulevardul Magheru. Bulevardul Unirii, formerly called, under communism, the "Boulevard of the Victory of Socialism," was vastly expanded in the 1980s under the dictator Nicolae Ceauşescu and was bordered by such buildings as the palatial marble House of the People (Casa Poporului, named now the Palace of the Parliament).





The CONFERENCE **GLOBAL CHALLENGES IN VALUATION**

The topics for the conference will reflect the latest challenges on the global agenda of valuation professionals: ESG, the newest International Valuation Standards (IVS 2024), the European Valuation Standards (EVS), prudential value under the EU Capital Requirements Regulation (CRR), valuation for secured lending, AVM - automated valuation models, digitization and use of AI in valuation etc.

The event is a very special one for our community of valuers: The National Valuer Day. It is scheduled for the beginning of September, 6th -7th.

The event will take place over two days. First day will start with the 11th WAVO Congress (World Association of Valuation Organisations), an Opening Conference with all the participants (400-500) - and other small meetings in the afternoon. On the second day we will organize a Closing Conference and other simultaneous sessions, in 3 halls.
